STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN NMRTU YUMA, AZ OVERSEAS SCREENING DEPARTMENT
AND ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE MEMBER & DEPENDENTS

Subj: STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING

1. This statement is to establish and acknowledge the responsibilities of the Active duty service members and dependents in regards to their overseas suitability screenings.
2. The following will be acknowledged with the ADSM's or spouses initials and signature indicating the rights and responsibilities for the overseas screening process.

_____ Member/dependent will ensure that dental is completed prior to returning packet to the Overseas Screening Office.

_____ If member has orders to an overseas duty station, MSG (Marine Security Guard), or MSAU (Marine Security Augmentation Unit) **all dependents** must be medically screened at least 30-45 days before PCS date.

_____ Service member/dependent understands that if Overseas Screening packet is turned in less than 30 days prior to PCS date it could result in a delay of travel.

_____ Any special education or medical inquiry that is required to be cleared by gaining command for service members or dependents can delay the process. It is the individual's right and responsibility to follow up with Overseas Screening Office for updates on inquiry responses. Packet will not be returned completed until a response and recommendation is received from gaining command.

_____ Any inquiry response is at the discretion of gaining command medical and not NMRTU Yuma Overseas screening's decision.

_____ Service member/dependent understands if immunization records cannot be obtained an immunity test must be ordered.

_____ Service member/dependent understands all care received at a civilian practice that is requested by screener (to include any sensitive information) must be obtained and given to Overseas Screening Office with any packets.
