## PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

### Northern San Diego County:

- The North County Transit District (NCTD) includes trains and buses that primarily serve Northern San Diego County.

- Naval Hospital Camp Pendleton is accessible via route 392 and has a bus stop on Mercy Circle.
  - Breeze buses serve all of North County, **including Camp Pendleton**
  - Sprinter (light rail line) runs east-west through Oceanside, Vista, San Marcos, and Escondido
  - Coaster (commuter train) links Oceanside to Downtown San Diego

### Riverside County:

- 511 - One-stop phone and web service for transportation information in Riverside and San Bernardino Counties.

### Orange County:

  - Scroll to menu at bottom of page to access the “Getting Around” options for bus and Senior Transportation options.

**\*\* Helpful Tip:** Most map apps for Smart Phones, (i.e. Google Maps) have a Transit feature that identifies the bus routes and location of bus stops.

1. Type the address of your destination
2. Hit “Directions”.
3. Tap on the “Transit” option for preferred mode of transportation.
4. A map to the bus stop and route should be visible once you select the desired bus route, and occasionally the cost of the ticket will be visible as well. \*\*
